REGULATIONS made by the Governor-General in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 18(9) of the Belize Constitution, Chapter 4 of the Substantive Laws of Belize, Revised Edition 2011, and all other powers thereunto him enabling.

**BELIZE CONSTITUTION (EMERGENCY POWERS)
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2020**

and shall be read and construed as one with the Belize Constitution (Emergency Powers) Regulations, 2020 which, as amended, are hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations.

2. The principal regulations are amended in regulation 9 (1) (b) by inserting immediately after sub-paragraph (xx) the following—

Amendment of regulation 9.

“(xxi) all other businesses, establishments, shops, offices, organizations and other similar entities, and services not specifically mentioned under this regulation,

provided that all schools shall remain closed;

and provided further that businesses and activities prohibited under regulations

10 and 15, or restricted under regulation 14, shall remain prohibited and restricted, respectively;”

Commencement. 3. These Regulations come into force on May 4th 2020.
